
- Microsoft PocketPC SE

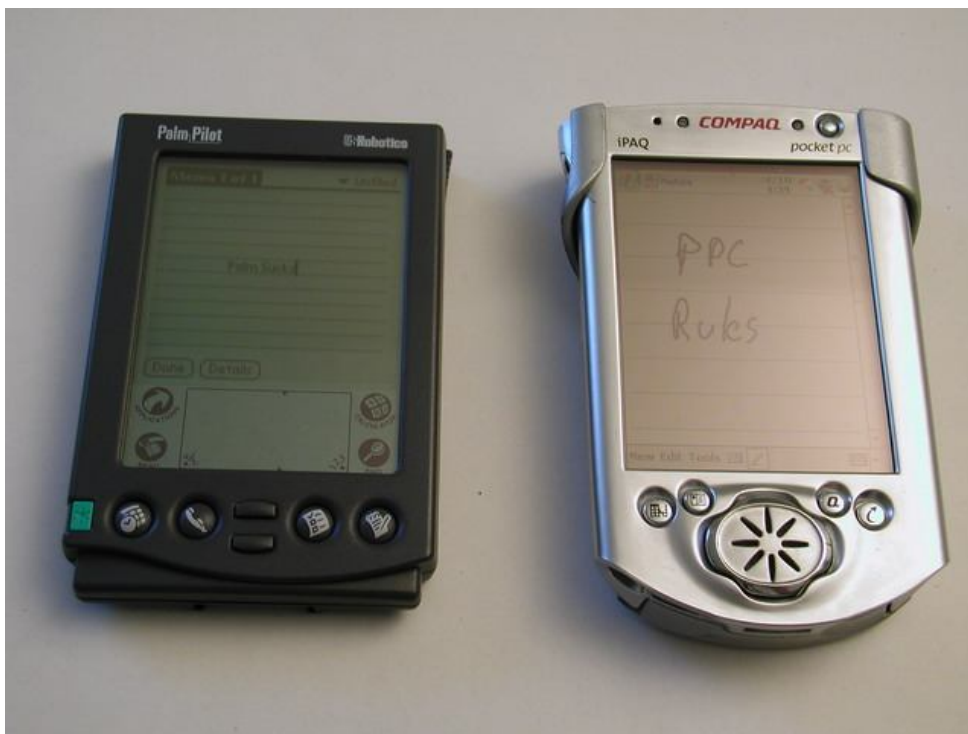

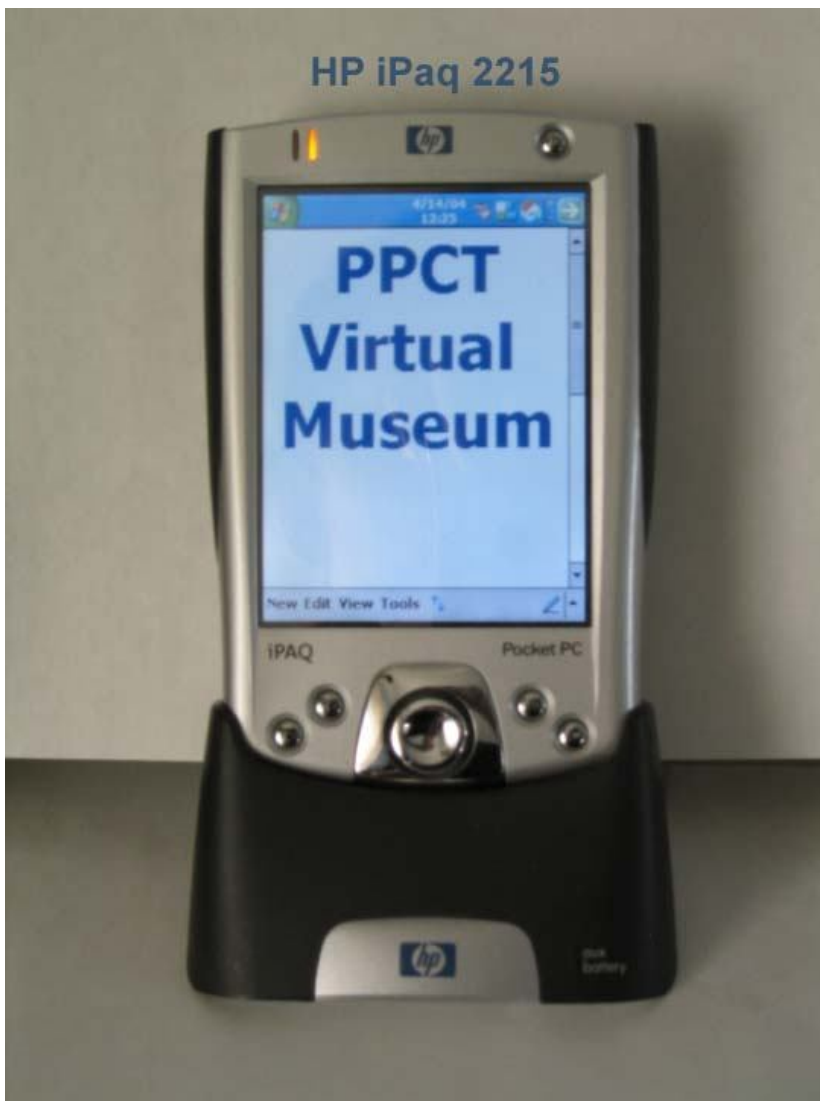
